18-30 MEMBER APPLICATION CRITERIA

Welcome, Applicants!

Please ensure you read all of the information on this page before filling in your application.

HWAT welcomes enquiries and applications regarding membership from artists and craftspeople living permanently or working from studios within our designated area. This year we are inviting **creative people aged 18 to 30*** to apply to exhibit work in a **group location** not far from The Farmers Kitchen, in the centre of the **2019 Art Trail**. Applicants do not need to be working full time as an artist or craftspeople to qualify, but do need to have a body of high quality work to exhibit. We anticipate applicants will have either:

A) recently left school after A levels and are aspiring to develop their practical skills working in the visual arts or

B) recently graduated from art college or university and are aiming to do the same.

We acknowledge that it is highly likely that candidates may well have other paid work in support of this aim and will not yet be "professional" artists at this point in their development.

Successful applicants will need to be present in the group space on the agreed Open Studio Art Trail weekends to meet visitors and to supervise the sale of their work during the opening times.

To promote the trail, HWAT holds a showcase or taster exhibition before and sometimes during the main trail. 18-30 members are invited to provide one artwork each for this exhibition. Further information regarding this will be provided in the New Year.

HWAT is an artist led collective with an elected Committee of three; Chair, Treasurer and Secretary. 18 to 30 members are welcome to attend HWAT meetings to get an insight into how members support the group's tasks and procedures, including the following: Publicity, New Member Selection, Brochure Production, Social Media and Exhibitions (putting up, stewarding, taking down etc.) as necessary. The 18 to 30 group will be represented at meetings by the group's organiser who is a full HWAT member.

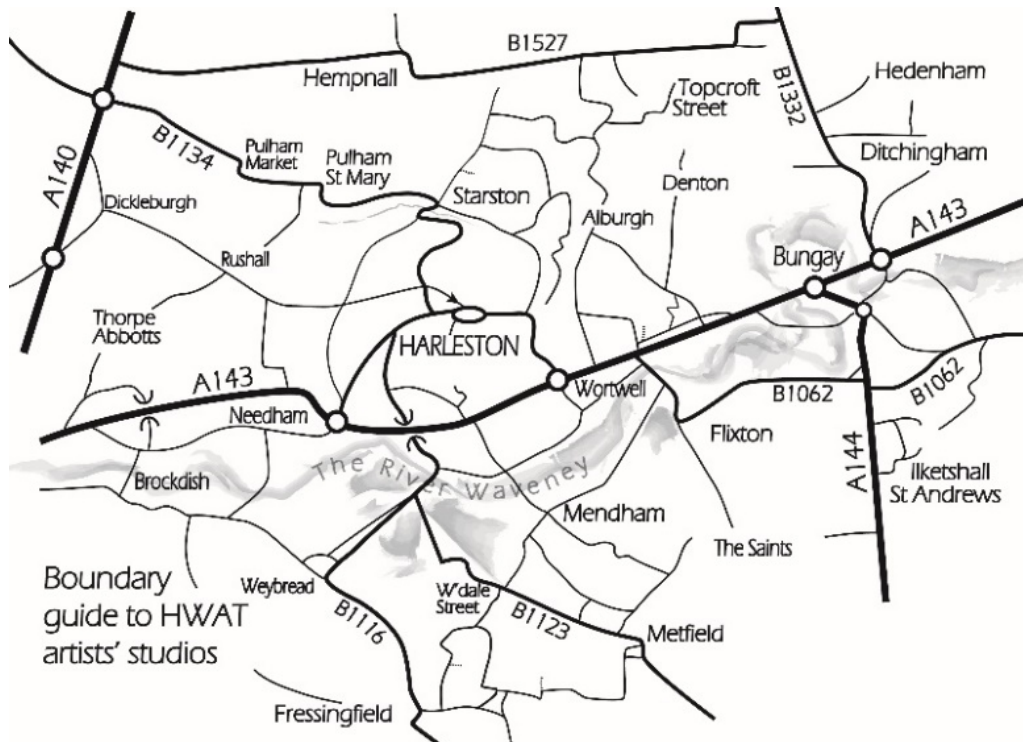
Each 18 to 30 member should pay the annual agreed **18 to 30 membership fee** which is **£30** this year. We aim always to keep this to an affordable level. If, at the end of the 2019 Art Trail you would like to apply to become a full member, you will be required to submit your application before the end of September 2019. *This is not a strict policy. If you are over 30 but fit the other criteria then you are welcome to apply. Each application will be assessed on an individual basis. Artists over 35 would normally be expected to make a full application to HWAT in the usual way and are unlikely to be included in this initiative.
